

Notice of Finding of No Significant Impact
For the City of Prescott
Airport and Sundog Main Sewer Improvement, Upsizing and Lift Station Projects
Public Noticed on December 29, 2017 in the Prescott Daily Courier

The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) has received a request for financial assistance from the City of Prescott for a Clean Water infrastructure project. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public and request comments.

WIFA staff analysis concluded that the following project neither individually nor cumulatively has a significant effect on the human environment. Therefore, the project qualifies for a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI).

The project will allow the City to move towards centralization of its wastewater treatment and reclamation system, reduce operating and maintenance costs, and better comply with federal and state requirements. Creating a centralized system will have the additional benefit of reducing fluoride levels at the Airport Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) to support permit compliance with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ). The Sundog Trunk Main includes the realignment or rehabilitation in place of approximately 9,200 linear feet of existing deteriorated and undersized sewer trunk main. The Airport Trunk Main Sewer Improvement project includes upsizing approximately 15,500 linear feet from SR89 and old SR89A to the Airport WWTP.

All written comments must be received no later than 5 p.m., 30 days from the publishing date.
