For the Camp Verde Sanitary District Refinance RD Debt

The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) has received a request for financial assistance from the Camp Verde Sanitary District to refinance a loan from the U.S. Department of Agriculture – Rural Development (USDA-RD) for a previously completed wastewater infrastructure project. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public and request comments.

Upon review of the Environmental Assessment prepared by USDA-RD for the Camp Verde Sanitary District Project, WIFA concurs with USDA-RD's March 1997 Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) that the project neither individually nor cumulatively has a significant effect on the human environment.

The original construction project included collection system improvements to the I-17 annexed area, a new interceptor, a new main pump station and improvements to the wastewater treatment plant. These improvements occurred in 2007 and were funded by the USDA-RD.
