

Notice of Finding of No Significant Impact
For the City of Globe
Arlington Area Waterline Project
Public Noticed in the Arizona Silver Belt on March 29, 2017

The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) has received a request for financial assistance from the City of Globe for a Drinking Water infrastructure project. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public and request comments.

WIFA staff analysis concluded that the following project neither individually nor cumulatively has a significant effect on the human environment. Therefore, the following project qualifies for a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) under the National Environmental Policy Act.

The City of Globe proposes to install a new 8-inch water pipeline to serve its Arlington Tank near Globe, Gila County, Arizona. The project area consists of a 1,600-foot-long and 40-foot-wide disturbance area corridor. A portion of the line will be installed within existing pavement, with about 150 feet installed within a dirt road and 500 feet on undisturbed land. This proposed line will tie into an existing line connecting to Arlington Tank. Approximately 20 feet of the existing line to Arlington Tank will be replaced as part of this project. The waterline proposed for installation measures 8 inches in diameter and will be buried at a depth of 4 feet.
