Notice of Finding of No Significant Impact

For the City of Globe

Water Distribution System Improvements

The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) has received a request for financial assistance from the City of Globe for a Drinking Water infrastructure project. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public and request comments.

WIFA staff analysis concluded that the following project neither individually nor cumulatively has a significant effect on the human environment. Therefore, the following project qualifies for a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) under the National Environmental Policy Act.

The City of Globe is proposing to upgrade an aging drinking water delivery system located on and adjacent to U.S. 60. The proposed project consists of approximately 1.5 miles of new 8-inch ductile iron waterline along U.S. 60 between Bankers Street and the Globe Trailer Park Entrance within the City of Globe, Arizona. The waterline would lie principally under the existing paved roadway within Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) rights-of-way (ROWs).
