**Notice of Finding of No Significant Impact**

For the Town of Camp Verde

SR 260 Sewer Collection System Expansion

The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) has received a request for financial assistance from the Town of Camp Verde for a wastewater infrastructure project. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public and request comments.

Upon review of the June 2015 Environmental Assessment Re-evaluation prepared by the Arizona Department of Transportation for the SR 260: Thousand Trails to I-17 Project, WIFA concurs with the Arizona Department of Transportation's April 2000 Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) and June 2015 Environmental Assessment Re-evaluation that the project neither individually nor cumulatively has a significant effect on the human environment.

The Town desires to design and construct a sewer system extension in coordination with ADOT's concurrent project to widen State Route 260.
