WIFA Policy #: II.4

Purpose:

Describe the types of and funding sources for Technical Assistance offered by WIFA

Policy:

WIFA allocates funding for the following types of Technical Assistance:

- Planning and Design Technical Assistance – This funding assists individual drinking water or wastewater systems to conceive, plan, design, or develop infrastructure projects. Refer to Procedure II.4.1.
- Professional Technical Assistance – Professional Technical Assistance includes studies, surveys and other types of reports that provide benefit to a range of drinking water and wastewater systems statewide.
- Staff Technical Assistance – The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality manages these funds to provide assistance to individual drinking water systems for improvements of facility operations.

Technical Assistance funding may come from the following sources:

- 15% set-aside (Drinking Water)
- 2% set-aside (Drinking Water)
- Fees (Clean Water and Drinking Water)

WIFA will allocate set-aside funding in accordance with EPA regulations. The amounts of funding allocated to each type of Technical Assistance, if any, will be included in the Clean Water and Drinking Water Intended Use Plans for recommendation to the Board of Directors at the June board meeting.


