

Legislative Representative Designation

WIFA Policy #: I.8

Purpose:

To designate lobbyists to represent WIFA.

Policy:

Section 1: Designated and Authorized Lobbyists

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes Title 41, Chapter 7, Article 8.1, the Board of Directors hereby authorizes the following individuals to represent WIFA on matters before the Legislature:

- Designated Lobbyist: Designated Lobbyist for the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality
- Authorized Lobbyist: Chairman of the Board of Directors
- Authorized Lobbyist: Executive Director of WIFA

Section 2: Legislative Policy

The Board of Directors hereby delegates legislative policy to the Executive Committee in accordance with this Policy.

WIFA Legislative Initiatives – Prior to the Start of a Legislative Session

Prior to the start of a legislative session and prior to action by WIFA representatives, the Executive Committee will review and make recommendations to the Board on legislative proposals generated by WIFA.

WIFA Legislative Initiatives – After the Start of a Legislative Session

If the legislative session has started, the Executive Committee may review legislative proposals generated by WIFA.

Non-WIFA Legislative Initiatives

The Executive Committee may review non-WIFA initiated legislative proposals and may provide comment.
