WIFA Announces Loan Closing for Truxton Canyon Water Company, Inc.

PHOENIX (April 19, 2016) – Truxton Canyon Water Company, Inc. will be making much-needed improvements to its drinking water system. The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) announced today that it has closed a \$350,950 loan with Truxton to resolve arsenic exceedances.

Truxton Canyon Water Company, Inc., a privately-owned water company located in Mohave County, serves approximately 950 residential and six commercial customers just north of Kingman. WIFA financing will be used for critical infrastructure improvements including the installation of a centralized arsenic treatment system and a structure to house the treatment facility.

“Updates to this drinking water system are long overdue,” said WIFA Board Chairman Misael Cabrera, who is also Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality. “We are happy to see this company moving forward with providing water that meets drinking water quality standards.”

WIFA is a state agency dedicated to protecting public health and promoting environmental quality through financial assistance for water and wastewater infrastructure. WIFA offers funding for drinking water, wastewater and stormwater projects designed to ensure safe, reliable drinking water and proper wastewater treatment. Over the last 25 years, WIFA has invested over \$2 billion in Arizona's communities.
