### WIFA Announces \$2 Million Loan Closing with Camp Verde Sanitary District in Yavapai County

PHOENIX (July 23, 2009) – The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) announced today that it will close a \$2 million loan with the Camp Verde Sanitary District for completion of construction of its wastewater treatment plant.

The funds will be used to complete installation of the collection line system and provide for other system upgrades required by the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ). In addition, funds will be utilized to implement improvements to the Main Street Lift Station.

WIFA has been assisting Camp Verde Sanitary District since 2004. The Camp Verde Sanitary District serves a about 3,000 customers.

“These funds provide much-needed help for this important wastewater project. We’re pleased to make this loan, making the most of Arizona’s precious water resources and protecting public health and safety,” said WIFA Board Chairman Benjamin H. Grumbles, who is also Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.
