WIFA Announces \$1.3 Million Loan to City of Prescott for Wastewater Project Master Plans

PHOENIX (June 25, 2009) – The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) announced today that a \$1.3 million loan has been awarded to the City of Prescott for the design and engineering of upgrades for two wastewater treatment facilities.

The loan will fund new master plans for upgrades and increased capacity for the Sundog and Airport Wastewater Treatment Facilities.

The City of Prescott has more than 17,000 connections serving about 43,200 customers. WIFA has provided financial assistance to the City of Prescott since 2003.

“These funds provide much-needed help for important wastewater treatment projects in Prescott. We’re pleased to make these loans, making the most of Arizona’s precious water resources and boosting infrastructure services to protect public health and safety,” said WIFA Board Chairman Benjamin H. Grumbles, who is also Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.
