WIFA Announces \$343,000 Loan to Virgin River Domestic Water Improvement District in Littlefield

PHOENIX (Aug.14, 2009) – The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) announced today that it will close a \$343,000 loan with the Virgin River Domestic Water Improvement District located in the community of Littlefield in Mohave County.

The \$343,000 loan will fund a new 150,000 gallon a day wastewater treatment facility that will produce Class A+ effluent, and help keep nearby Beaver Dam wash clean. The Virgin River district is in the northwest corner of Arizona, about 10 miles northeast of Mesquite, Nev.

“These funds provide much-needed help for this important wastewater project. We’re pleased to make this loan, making the most of Arizona’s precious water resources and protecting public health and safety,” said WIFA Board Chairman Benjamin H. Grumbles, who is also Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.
