The WIFA Chairman of the Board and the WIFA Executive Director certify that this ARRA infrastructure investment of \$172,285 has received the full review and vetting required by law and accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. This investment will fund:


The project will be a 1.5 MGD expansion to the plant and include the following components:

- One new 16" influent pump (replacing the existing 12" pump);
- One additional multi-celled secondary treatment (anoxic/aeration) basin;
- One addition mixed liquor recycle pump station;
- One additional aeration blower;
- One additional secondary clarifier;
- One additional sludge pump station (RAS and WAS) to serve the new clarifier;
- One additional scum pump station;
- One additional set of tertiary filters;
- One additional chlorine contact basin for 1.5 mgd design average flow capacity;
- Additional effluent discharge pipeline to drainage channel;
- New yard piping;
- Electrical and plant control system additions and modifications;
- Remodeled administration building and laboratory upgrades;
- Site drainage; and
- Site roads and improvements to existing roadways.

The WWTP Upgrades and Expansion – Phase 2 project has an estimated total cost of \$12,000,000 for the Town of Buckeye. This certification will be posted on www.azwifa.gov which links to recovery.gov.
