

**American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) 1511 Certification**  
Loan Number 92A149-10 – July 17, 2009

Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) 1511 Project Certification

The WIFA Chairman of the Board and the WIFA Executive Director certify that this ARRA infrastructure investment of \$7,211,573.40 has received the full review and vetting required by law and accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. This investment will fund the following projects:

DW-038: The transmission pipelines will carry large volumes of water for several miles to service areas which are dependent upon a centralized surface water treatment plant. These water mains will provide an interconnection between the existing Lake Pleasant Road transmission main and the City's future pressure zone 2/3 transmission main system.

DW-111: This project will provide funding for the installation of SCADA controls and monitoring devices to the existing Cotton Crossing PRV station.


DW-124: This project will equip the existing well casing located at 99th Avenue and Rose Garden alignment. Once equipped, this well will directly feed into the City's existing water distribution system pressure zone No. 3.

DW-181: The Stone Street well/reservoir/booster site will undergo a significant upgrade consisting of the replacement of many original functional systems to meet current Peoria standards. The project will also include installing SCADA controls and monitoring devices that allow the City to operate the site more efficiently.
