This investment will fund:


#### Small Diameter Sewer Rehab

This project will rehabilitate approximately 41,000 linear feet of small diameter sewer. The project will utilize cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining technology with the full structural strength of the original pipe. The joint-less technology will extend the sewer life 50+ years and eliminate the potential for pipe collapse.


#### Relief Sewers for South West Phoenix

This project will entail construction of nearly 122 linear feet of 27-inch diameter sewer, 664 linear feet of 36-inch diameter sewer, 400 linear feet of 15-inch diameter sewer, 100 linear feet of 24-inch diameter sewer, several associated manholes and/or junction structures, and other related construction activities, including but not limited to sewer bypass and traffic re-routing.
