
Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) 1511 Project Certification.

The WIFA Chairman of the Board and the WIFA Executive Director certify that this ARRA infrastructure investment of \$1,600,000 has received the full review and vetting required by law and accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. This investment will fund:

The HOPE (Homeownership Opportunities for People Everywhere) VI Project is a program created to rebuild old and/or severely distressed public housing. The primary goals include revitalizing the neighborhood bounded by 7th Avenue to 15th Avenue from I-17 Freeway to Buckeye Road. The City will upgrade the water system in the project area by installing 8,600 LF of new main in the streets' right of way, relocation 260 meters and associated services and installing 25 new fire hydrants in the neighborhood.

The Water Main Replacement for the HOPE VI project has an estimated total cost of \$2,000,000 for the City of Phoenix. This certification will be posted on www.azwifa.gov which links to recovery.gov.
