### **Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) 1511 Project Certification**

The WIFA Chairman of the Board and the WIFA Executive Director certify that this ARRA infrastructure investment of \$1,200,000 has received the full review and vetting required by law and accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. This investment will fund:


To reuse reclaimed water, the City will modify the SPA-1 Reclaimed Booster Station to create a point of connection to the City of Surprise reclaimed water system at Litchfield Road and Waddell Road.

The Booster Station includes a vault, pumps, piping and plumbing, valves, sensors, instrumentation, ventilation, above ground equipment pads and enclosures, electrical, and controls.

The site work includes removal & replacement of pavement, sidewalks, curb & gutter; installation of a 20-foot driveway, 16" DIP reclaimed line, 16" gate valve, bacteriological sampling station, 4" DIP sewer force main, and landscaping.

The Litchfield Road Reclaimed Water Booster Station project has an estimated total cost of \$1,500,000 for the City of Surprise. This certification will be posted on [www.azwifa.gov](http://www.azwifa.gov) which links to [recovery.gov](http://recovery.gov).
