Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) 1511 Project Certification.


The WIFA Chairman of the Board and the WIFA Executive Director certify that this ARRA infrastructure investment of \$1,150,000 has received the full review and vetting required by law and accept responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. This investment will fund:

The Tubac Water system will treat the water from Well 4 and Well 5 to comply with the EPA Arsenic MCL of 10 ppb; thus no longer use the other wells that are in excess of the limit. Arsenic removal vessels which use iron-based absorption media will be installed at Well 5. The water from Well 4 will be piped to Well 5 through an existing transmission line. A new transmission line will be constructed to carry the treated water back into the distribution system.

The project has an estimated total cost of \$2,300,000 for the Arizona-American Water Company. This certification will be posted on www.azwifa.gov which links to recovery.gov.
