
Implementing a SCADA platform will optimize utility operations by finding and managing efficiencies, increasing the level of customer service and eliminating unnecessary expenses.

In order to reduce arsenic treatment costs, VWC will connect the existing Evergreen No. 2 well to the centralized Sonoran Vista arsenic treatment facility, which is more efficient.
