



REQUEST FOR DESIGN & PLANNING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROJECT PROPOSALS FY2010

The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) is requesting applications for Design & Planning Technical Assistance (TA) projects that address drinking water and wastewater facilities throughout the State of Arizona. TA awards are applied to non-construction related activities that include pre-design, design, sustainable/green infrastructure, and managerial and financial capacity building.

AVAILABLE FUNDING

There will be approximately \$1,000,000 available for the fiscal year 2010 TA funding cycle, allocated as follows:

Traditional & Green Projects	Green Projects Only
\$500,000 - DW (For population served \leq 10,000)	\$200,000 - DW (no population restrictions)
\$150,000 - CW (no population restrictions)	\$150,000 - CW (no population restrictions)

PROJECT ELIGIBILITIES

The TA program provides funding non-construction related activities that include pre-design, design, sustainable/green infrastructure, and managerial and financial capacity building.

EVALUATION

All applications will be evaluated and scored based on how the project:

- Corrects current conditions that contribute to surface water pollution, run-off, groundwater pollution
- Contributes to water quality improvement
- Promotes sustainable/green infrastructure design, renewable energy and energy conservation
- Improves technical, managerial and financial capability

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LOCAL MATCH

Traditional projects will have a 50/50 local match component that may be comprised of additional funding sources such as cash, grants, loans, or may consist of in-kind services.

Projects that demonstrate commitment toward sustainable design and/or green infrastructure will have NO local match component requirement.

APPLICATION & DEADLINES

Applications for both clean water and drinking water TA's will be available online through the WIFA website at www.azwifa.gov on April 13, 2009 and shall remain open until midnight on June 1, 2009. WIFA staff will be available to assist you with questions regarding your project and application.

AWARDS

TA funding awards will be announced at the WIFA Board of Director's Meeting at 1:30 pm on June 17, 2009.
